Log in to GenePattern

1. In the menu bar, choose Insert → Insert Cell Above/Below (shortcut a/b)
2. In the menu bar, choose Cell → Cell Type → GenePattern (shortcut g)
3. In the GenePattern login cell, select the desired server from the dropdown list
4. Enter your username and password and click Log into GenePattern

Add a GenePattern analysis cell

1. Make sure you are logged in to a GenePattern server (see Login to GenePattern above)
2. In the menu bar, choose Insert → Insert Cell Above/Below (shortcut a/b)
3. In the menu bar, choose Cell → Cell Type → GenePattern (shortcut g)
4. In the module selection window, find the desired module by doing one of the following:
 - a. Scroll to the module
 - b. Type the module's name in the search bar (which reads "Type to Filter")
 - c. Type related keywords in the search bar
5. Click on the desired module

Enter formatted text

1. In the menu bar, choose Insert → Insert Cell Above/Below (shortcut a/b)
2. In the menu bar, choose Cell → Cell Type → Markdown (shortcut m)
 - To enter text in Markdown, use the guides below.
 - To enter text in word-processor mode, click the  icon.
 - To render the formatted text, click

GenePattern Notebook Keyboard Shortcuts

Command Mode (type **Esc** to enable)

General

F : find and replace
↵ : enter edit mode
⌘ ⇧ P : open the command palette

Run cells

⇧ ↵ : run cell, select below
^ ↵ : run selected cells
⌘ ↵ : run cell, insert below

Convert cell type

Y : to code
M : to markdown
R : to raw
G : to GenePattern
1 : to heading 1
2 : to heading 2
3 : to heading 3
4 : to heading 4
5 : to heading 5
6 : to heading 6

Select cells

K : select cell above
↑ : select cell above
↓ : select cell below
J : select cell below
⇧ **K** : extend selected cells above
⇧ ↑ : extend selected cells above
⇧ ↓ : extend selected cells below
⇧ **J** : extend selected cells below

Manipulate cells

A : insert new cell above
B : insert new cell below
X : cut cell
C : copy cell
⇧ **V** : paste cell above
V : paste cell below
Z : undo cell deletion
DD : delete selected cell
⇧ **M** : merge selected cells, or current cell with cell below if only one cell selected

Document and system operations

⌘ **S** : Save and Checkpoint
S : Save and Checkpoint
II : interrupt kernel
OO : restart the kernel (with dialog)
Esc : enter Command Mode
Q : close the pager

View options

L : toggle line numbers
O : toggle output of selected cells
⇧ **O** : toggle output scrolling of selected cells
H : show keyboard shortcuts
⇧ ⌘ : scroll notebook up
⌘ : scroll notebook down

Edit Mode

(type **Enter** to enable)

Used while editing cell contents

→ : code completion or indent
⇧ → : tooltip
⌘] : indent
⌘ [: dedent
⌘ **A** : select all
⌘ **Z** : undo
⌘ ⇧ **Z** : redo
⌘ **Y** : redo
⌘ ↑ : go to cell start
⌘ ↓ : go to cell end
⌘ ← : go one word left
⌘ → : go one word right
⌘ ⌘ : delete word before
⌘ ⌘ : delete word after
^ **M** : command mode
Esc : command mode
⌘ ⇧ **P** : open the command palette
⇧ ↵ : run cell, select below
^ ↵ : run selected cells
⌘ ↵ : run cell, insert below
^ ⇧ - : split cell
⌘ **S** : Save and Checkpoint
↓ : move cursor down
↑ : move cursor up
